

Report on Event-Information Literacy on Biological Science Program

Landing of American satellite Apollo 11 on moon “A giant leap for mankind” fifty years ago was celebrated by the department of Zoology along with Library committee of G. M. Momin Women's College by organising a programme on Information Literacy in Biological Sciences on 21st July 2018.

A group of 40 final year students assembled in the library to get informed on the facilities and smart use of Library. The objective was to learn from our remarkable Librarian Mrs. Shad Patel on how to gather knowledge in biological sciences through the department of library and information sciences.

Librarian madam explained the use of various types of library books and services viz. General reference books and materials (encyclopedias, dictionaries, atlases, etc.), Theses, Dissertations, Periodicals, Reserve Books, Circulation Books and Special Collections.

Mrs. Shad Patel also explained the use of library catalogue and use of ‘OPAC’- online public access to catalogue.
