

DEPARTMENT OF LIFE LONG LEARNING AND EXTENSION (DLLE)

Year : 2022-2023

The Department of Lifelong Learning and Extension (DLLE) of our college work with an objective to empower our girl students with education, skill, carrier, confidence and sense of responsibility for the society. To fulfill the objectives various activities are undertaken throughout the year.

Training Sessions:

- The **University** Department of Lifelong Learning and Extension conducted **First term training** at SST college, Ulhasnagar on **23-08-2022**. One Extension work teachers (Dr. Vaishali) and two student managers (Ms. Aleena and Ms. Naba) attended the same.
- **First term training** at **College level** was conducted on **30-08-2022**. Total **241 students** attended the meeting. Mrs. Jayashree Thakre (Field Coordinator) and Dr. Dilip Ahuja (Field Coordinator) gave information about DLLE projects & activities to be carried out throughout the year. All the extension work teachers (5) were present.
- The **University** Department of Lifelong Learning and Extension conducted **Second term training** at Bhandodkar college, Thane on **29-11-2022**. One Extension work teachers (Dr. Vaishali) and two student managers (Ms. Mariya and Ms. Saoleha) attended the same.
- **Second term training** at **College level** was conducted on **17/02/2023**. Total **175 students** attended the meeting. Mrs. Jayashree Thakre (Field Coordinator) and Dr. Vaishali Nirmalkar gave information about writing of project reports.

Fresher students were informed about DLLE activities under Student Induction Programme (19, 20, 21/07/2022) by the extension work teachers (EWT). Registration of students for Extension Activities was carried out from July 2022 till September 2022. Annexure 1, 2, 3 and 4 which included the registration list and master sheet of enrolled students was submitted to the University DLLE on 10-09-2022. Total 241 students enrolled for DLLE. Activities under DLLE at college level and community level were carried out from October 2022 till February 2023. All the EWT and student managers actively worked for successful conduction of DLLE activities throughout the year. Annexures 5, 6, 7, 9, 10 and 10A which included the Examination wise list of FY, SY, TY and M.Sc were prepared from March 2023 till April 2023 and submitted to College and University for benefit of 10 grace marks to the students who successfully completed 120h of their extension work.

NIOS – National Institute of Open Schooling : Incharge – Dr. Tasmi Ansari

Students select career of their own choice, interview the persons with the same career and prepare pamphlets, charts and poster with their findings. Some of the careers chosen were data science, hotel manager, CA, Marketing manager, HR manager, Navy officer, Motivational speaker, Toll Plaza management, advocate, Dietician, Corporater, Pharmacist, Nutritionist, etc. Prize was given to best poster. Under NIOS students prepared charts and presented the same.

SWS – Status of Women in Society: Incharge – Mrs. Ruby Patel

The students registered under this project carried out survey of 40 women and analyzed it statistically. The areas covered were Gauri pada, Ambadi, Bhoi wada, Bangalpura, Khajoorpuda, Nizampur, madhav nagar, avachit pada, Dargah Road, Gaibi nagar, Samru Bagh, Hafiz nagar, Shastri nagar, etc. Interviews were taken going door to door and thus students also learnt the communication skills and building rapport with the community.

APY – Annapoorna Yojana: Incharge – Dr. Heena Momin

Objectives of this project are to prepare the students to be independent, to orient students towards constructive and inventive role and to provide them with skills of entrepreneurship. The items sold were chicken samosa, meduwada, sandwiches, sprouts, cupcakes, corn chat, Dosa, chat, Panipuri, Sandwich Nalli batata, Chana masala, noodles, momos sev puri, chana, etc ear rings, cosmetics, jewelry, botanical instruments, Hand Purse, Dress Material, Pen and Pencil holder, Notebooks, Scale, watches, etc..
