

Principal's Report 2019-20

I am honoured and it gives me great divine pleasure to present before you the annual report of our KME Society's G.M.Momin Women's College for the year 2019-20.

The College today:

Our college was established with the motive of spreading awareness on higher education among women, especially those hailing from the minority Muslim population, and the economically challenged sections of the society; and facilitating the same through appropriate effective action. The college has grown from strength to strength over the years: from a modest beginning in 1989 with only 94 students, the college today has over 1600 women students enrolled in various Under-Graduate and Post-Graduate programmes in the faculties of Arts, Science and Commerce. Apart from conventional courses leading to graduation, the college also enrolls students for BMS, B.Sc. (Biotechnology), B.Sc. (Inter-disciplinary Studies), B.Sc. (IT), M.A., M.Com., M.Sc., M.Sc. (IT) and Ph.D. programmes of the University of Mumbai. In a relatively short span of 31 years since inception, the college has achieved landmark honours and recognitions such as:

- Twinned with Indian Council of Agricultural Research (ICAR) Research Complex for North East Hill Region, Meghalaya since September 2018 under DBT Research Project.
- Twinned with an Institution of Higher Learning from Odisha under Ek Bharat Shreshth Bharat Scheme of Government of India 2019
- Thirty University Ranks, featuring Twenty seven students, nine ranks of which are in the last 5 years
- Two University Ranks of other Universities in last 5 years

Our teachers jointly hold 3 patents and 3 National Service Medals. Our College was successfully registered with the NIRF once again this year due to untiring efforts of the IQAC team. We have also applied for the College of Potential Excellence and are awaiting the outcome. We started Earn and Learn Scheme, Mentor System, a 'Cycling Club' and 'Positive Thinkers Club' for all round development, physical and emotional wellbeing. The International Day of Yoga is celebrated appropriately with due respects to individual and community health. Our team won the second position after reaching the final round of CII (Confederation of Indian Industry) National Debate Competition on the theme 'the India we want', finals of which were held in Mumbai.

Principal (Dr.) Moses Kolet and Dr Kamran Abbas Mirza had presented the college and its activities before the task force panel of Ministry of Science and Technology at Alleppy, Kerala in October 2018 which resulted in our college coming under the umbrella of FIST from this year. Similarly Principal Dr. Kolet along Dr. Tarannum Attar, Dr. Nandita Singh, Ms. Jayashree Thakre, Dr. Kamran Abbas, Ms. Nusrat Ansari and Mr. Nadeem Dhange successfully presented, represented and brought our college under RUSA support which was activated during this year. This year also marked the beginning of EPF in the college. The BMS faculty was recommended for permanent affiliation by the University of Mumbai during the year. This academic year began on an auspicious note just after Ramzan Eid, and Eid party was arranged by the staff academy committee for all staff wherein the students and staff participating in Earn and Learn Scheme were felicitated.

Our teacher Dr. Anis Choudhery was selected as a member of the delegation of University of Mumbai Sindhu Swadhyaya Sanstha to interact with officials of National Institute of Hydrography and Indian Navy. Dr. Vaishali Nirmalkar was selected as district co-coordinator for Avishkar Research Convention by the University of Mumbai, also as Resource Person for Avishkar District level Workshop and was on deputation as teacher coordinator to the University of Mumbai which is hosting the State level Inter University Avishkar Research Convention and later the All India West Zone Anveshan Research Convention.. Our teacher Dr. Tarannum Attar was invited as jury member for the Avishkar research convention district level rounds. Ms. Jayashree Thakre and Dr. Vaishali Nirmalkar conducted DLLE orientation sessions in colleges on behalf of University of Mumbai. Our college played its role in the New Draft Education Policy by sending suggestions received from our teachers and interacting with Dr M.K.Sridhar and Dr. Vasudha Kamat, both members of the team constituted for framing the New Education Policy. Dr. Vaishali Nirmalkar participated in Panel Discussion on the New Draft Education Policy organized on the occasion of Teachers Day by KME Society. Dr Vaishali Nirmalkar was selected by the management for the Best Teacher Award 2019. Our young teachers Ms. Fatima Momin, Ms. Naziya Momin and Ms. Asba Ansari updated all staff on 'Current Strategies of Teaching in Higher Education', as grasped by them in their Faculty Development Programme at Indian Institute of Science Education and Research, Pune. 10 students were invited by St Xavier's College, our MoU partner college to attend their Malhar Festival on 16 and 17 August 2019. One student Ms. Neha B. Shaikh was selected as cabin crew in Vistara Tata SIA Airlines. Licence for ISO 9001:2015 was received from Bureau of Indian Standards (BIS). We were invited to be a part of Ek Bharat Shreshtha Bharat Abhiyaan of Govt. of India. Ms. Ulfa Kazi Topped the entire Post Graduation Results of Science faculty taken together, in the University of Mumbai scoring highest aggregate marks

As part of institutional responsibility our college conducted several outreach programmes in and around Bhiwandi on cyber security, innovations in microscopy and as per wishes of Hon'ble President of KME Society, has a MoU for academic interaction with our own KMES High School and Junior College, Padgha since 2019. Bhiwandi biologists Association has been constituted this year bt special efforts of Dr. Anis Choudhery and Dept. of Zoology for conservation of local resources. Bioguardian Award has also been installed for this work. The first Bio-guardian Award was conferred upon Dr. Sawant, Eminent Zoologist and Former Principal of BNN College on his 80th birthday on 8th August 2019. Two of our students reached up to the final rounds of All India Debate Competition 2019-20 organized annually by Confederation of Indian Industry (CII) and secured the second position in this national event. Today several of our students are entrepreneurs and philanthropists and having established their own brands, are successfully running their business enterprises online. A group of students operates a charity group to help the needy with their educational, food, other needs such as marriage expenses and other emergency needs. It is a matter of pride that we have a Polymerase Chain Reaction (PCR) Machine in our Department of Biotechnology; only a handful of institutions have this valuable asset in their stocks and many more such high end technological advancements will be added shortly under support from FIST of Ministry of Science and Technology. Our student Ms. Kavya R. Venkatesh secured 25th Rank in CS Foundation Examination results declared in July 2019. Dr. Seema Habib obtained honourary degree of Doctor of Science (D.Sc.) (Honoris) from International Agency for Standards & Ratings. She also got her recognition as Guiding teacher for M.Sc. Organic Chemistry by Papers and by Research..

Dr Anis Choudhery was awarded Ph.D degree in Zoology by the University of Mumbai in August 2019. Prin. Dr Moses Kolet and Office Superintendent Mr. Mushtaq Ali Patel were invited by Confederation of Indian Industry for a ministerial interaction on Mission Skill India on 13/8/2019 wherein they got a unique chance to interact with Dr. Mahendranath Pandey, Union Minister for Skill Development and Entrepreneurship, Dr. K.P Krishnan, Chief Secretary, Mr. Rajesh Agrawal, Joint Secretary, Union Ministry for Skill Development and Entrepreneurship and Mr. Sambhaji Patil Nilangekar, then state minister for skill development, Mrs Sujata Saunik, Addl. Chief Secretary, Govt. of Maharashtra and their teams and Ms. Kashmir Mewawala, Chairperson of CII at Hotel Taj Mahal Palace. Principal Dr. Moses Kolet was invited to Judge the Presentations at Ministry of Ayush event on Arogya Expo at International Exhibition Centre Vashi. Three (industry/NGO and institution) MoUs were signed this year and more are in the pipeline. Several Directors, Defence Officers, Principals, Senior Academicians, National and International Executives visited our college during this year inclusive of World Bank Executive Ms. Sameena Dost, initiated into our college by Mr. Aslam Fakhir sir, our beloved President of KME Society. Our student Ms. Ramin Ansari was invited by NGO Sevadharm and Thane Police to give an appropriate formal informative speech for their event to commemorate Gandhi Jayanti at St. John the Baptist School Hall in Thane. The Hon'ble Collector of Thane District invited us to participate, with teacher in voter awareness skit competitions before the vidhan sabha elections; our team participated with script drafted by our student Ms. Naba Momin and won the second prize, and got specially congratulated by the Hon'ble collector himself in person. For the first time in our history we entered in an intercollegiate dramatics event with our play 'Ek Kahani Aisi Bhi' and our girls swept all the awards. Additional funding and amounts visualized only in dreams have arrived under Star College Scheme, FIST and RUSA and project implementations have begun. All these milestones are a result of the hard work of my dedicated group of staff and students and the management's belief in me. For all the above glorious achievements and support, I am ever thankful to our management, staff, students and their parents, all other stake holders and above all 'Almighty Allah' for incessant blessings.

Results:

I am very happy and elated to announce that **Ms. Kazi Ulfa Irfan topped the entire Science Post Graduation Examinations in the University of Mumbai and was awarded The Swatantraveer Sawarkar Memorial Gold Medal** at the University convocation on 26/11/2019 . Her achievement was widely reported in the media.

First and Second Year examinations were handed over to the college by the University from this academic year 2019-20.

The college declared all results within the prescribed time limits. Results of the Semester II, IV and VI in the last academic year 2018-19 are as follows:

Faculty of Arts: The overall percentage of passing in the last under-graduate F.Y. and S.Y.B.A. examinations conducted in April-May 2019 was **50.00%** and **70.93%** respectively. In the T.Y.B.A. examination conducted by the University of Mumbai in April-May 2019, the college posted a successful result of **91.67%**. At the Post-Graduate M.A. examinations the overall result was **100%** at the M.A. (Part II) level.

Faculty of Science: The overall rate of success in the last under-graduate F.Y. and S.Y.B.Sc. examinations conducted in March-April 2019 was **61.72%** and **94.17%** respectively. In the T.Y.B.Sc. examination conducted by the University of Mumbai in April-May 2019 the overall percentage of passing was **87.96%**. At the Post-Graduate M.Sc. (Part II) level the overall result was **73.07%**. **100%** results were achieved by the Department of Physics, Botany and Zoology.

In the subject of B.Sc. (IT), results at F.Y. and S.Y.B.Sc. (IT) examinations were **93.94%** and **100%** respectively, while T.Y.B.Sc. (IT) posted a result of **93.02%**. **100%** result was achieved by the M.Sc. (IT) class in the last University examination.

In the subject of B.Sc. (Biotechnology) results at F.Y. and S.Y.B.Sc. examinations were **86.96%** and **95.45%** respectively, while T.Y.B.Sc. (Biotech) posted a result of **81.48%**.

The BSc (Inter Disciplinary Studies) Course posted a result of **65.79%** at the F.Y.B.Sc. and **94.73%** at S.Y.B.Sc. examinations respectively while T.Y.B.Sc. (ID) achieved result of **90.00%**.

Faculty of Commerce: The percentage of passing in the last under-graduate F.Y. and S.Y.B.Com. examinations conducted in April 2019 was **56.72%** and **86.84%** respectively. At the T.Y.B.Com. examination conducted by the University of Mumbai in April 2019, the college achieved a successful result of **91.66%**. At the Post-graduate M.Com. examination our result was **93.02%**.

The percentage of passing in the last under-graduate F.Y. and S.Y.B.M.S. examinations conducted in April-May 2019 was **87.04%** and **97.73%** respectively. In the T.Y.B.M.S. examination conducted by the University of Mumbai in April 2019, our college achieved a successful result of **92.85%**.

Results of all examinations conducted in 2018-19 and First term end examinations 2019-20 were declared within the stipulated period by the college I congratulate the students, teachers and support staff for the results achieved.

These collaborations provide multi-faceted academic, curricular, co-curricular and extra-curricular exposure to students and staff. Similar MoUs with other institutions are under process.

New Courses Introduced:

A new subject of NSS was introduced as an alternative to Foundation Course from this year. We have already received the necessary permissions and will be introducing a similar subject Lifelong Learning and Extension Education from the next year for our DLLE students.

Audits and Inspections:

The surveillance team from Bureau of Indian Standards granted upgraded version ISO 9001:2015 to our college.

Safety, Environment and Green Audits were successfully conducted through GESA Pro, an International certification agency in June 2019 and the college was certified accordingly.

Internal Academic audits were conducted in each semester. The last External Academic Audit was carried out under expert auditors Dr. Vijay Joshi, former Principal, Somaiya College (autonomous), Dr. Anil Patil, Principal, JSM College and former Director, BCUD, University of Mumbai and Dr. Mahendra Khandpekar, D.Sc., B.K. Birla College in April 2019 and the same will be carried out this year.

Star College Scheme:

I am happy to announce that we have received continued funding for two more years from the Department of Biotechnology, Ministry of Science and Technology, Government of India under Star College Scheme to our 5 departments of Botany, Chemistry, Information Technology, Physics and Zoology, for strengthening of the departments. A record of over 600 activities were successfully conducted under this scheme, benefitting over 4500 students, 100% staff from the concerned departments and 51 members of the non-teaching staff. We have guided two institutions for obtaining this scheme in their colleges of which one institute has received grants and the second has been invited to present their college and funds may follow shortly. Several inter and intra collegiate events, workshops and competitions were organized under the Star College Scheme for which the college is grateful to DBT.

Research Grant from Ministry of Science and Technology:

Prin. (Dr.) Moses Kolet and Dr. Subhashree Ghosh received financial grant of Rupees Eight Lakhs from Ministry of Science and Technology. We a twin institute, **Indian Council of Agricultural Research (ICAR)** Research Complex for North East Hill Region, Meghalaya under this project. Ms. Hiba Shaikh, our own alumna worked as Junior Research Fellow, the first JRF in our college, under this grant scheme which ended in September 2019.

Steps towards ICT and Digitalization:

Our admission process, all financial transactions with the University, fee transactions and declaration of results are online. All classrooms were made 'ICT enabled' during this year. Blue tooth enabled sound systems were installed in the larger classrooms. Some departments are using Google classroom for knowledge sharing. KOHA software was successfully installed and is being used in the library. New NAAC compliant website of global standards prepared by our teachers was launched in January 2020. Five smart boards have been sanctioned under RUSA funding.

Faculty Development Curriculum Related Activities:

Prin. (Dr.) Moses Kolet was nominated by the Hon.ble Vice Chancellor as VC's nominee on the Academic Council of S.K.Somaiya College (Autonomous). Four teachers, namely Mr. Amir Hamza, Dr. Tabassum Sheikh and Dr. Nooruddin Shaikh, Dr Nandita Singh contributed as members of Boards of Studies of the University of Mumbai respectively. Teachers contributed as members of various syllabus committees, as chair persons of examination panels of the University of Mumbai and paper setters, moderators and examiners for university examinations. 4 teachers contributed to Books in the subject of Zoology published by the University of Mumbai. Two teachers contributed to other text books. Dr. Seema Habib was appointed as Co-guide for PhD. 9 teachers completed refresher courses and faculty development programmes

Upgradation of Infrastructure:

Last year the fitness centre was upgraded with a new computerized commercial tread mill and many other newly added equipments along with upgraded steam bath facility. PCR machine, an asset available with only top research institutions was commissioned in the Department of Biotechnology; Scientific equipments and apparatus were added under star college scheme. New CCTV monitoring systems, ramps, railings and washroom facility for '*divyang*' were commissioned. The Physical Chemistry laboratory and main entrance were renovated. This year the auditoriums, staff room, canteen in main building and entire departments of Biotechnology, BMS, Commerce, Information Technology and Physics have been taken up for upgradation under RUSA scheme for attaining global standards; the works are in various stages of completion, and there are similar plans for all other departments as well. Carpentry work in Biotechnology, Chemistry, Botany and Zoology departments was completed. Processes for waterproofing of terrace and prevention of accumulation of water on terrace have been initiated. All large classrooms have been fitted with appropriate sound systems for better learning experience. These rooms will soon be equipped with Smart boards which are being provided by the government through our efforts. All class rooms and Laboratories are ICT enabled and equipped with electronic display systems during this year. We aim at having all world class facilities in our sacred institution.

Earn and Learn Scheme:

The scheme, implemented since 2016-17, helps needy students with their education. An amount of over Rs. 85,000/- was earned by seventeen needy students from participating in this scheme during the year 2019-20, helping them to fund their education. Last year 20 students had participated in Earn and learn Scheme operating under MoU with Quick Heal Foundation and earned over Rs. 63,000/- towards their education by spreading awareness on cyber security amongst 11,000 school and college students of nearby institutions. This year an amount of Rs. 30000/- has been earned by and distributed to students who helped applicants and

newcomers with our online admissions under earn and learn scheme. Over 38,000 school and college students have been sensitized on cyber security awareness during this year by our 40 volunteers. Students with talents and skills are given opportunities to conduct skill workshops for fellow students and due honourarium is remitted.

I am happy to announce that following our last year's success of the cyber security training and awareness scheme, this year the target has been doubled by the Quick Heal Foundation to 40 participating students who have been hand-picked and trained by the company in cyber security awareness to spread the message to 20,000 students of nearby institutions and am also happy to announce that this target of 20,000 has long been achieved and crossed by our students; till today over 38,000 school and college students have been sensitized this year and mission is accomplished. An amount of Rs. 210000/- has been granted for the same. I thank Ms. Sugandha Dani, Ms. Varsha and officials from Quick Heal Foundation and our IT department under able guidance of Ms. Nusrat Ansari for efficiently operating this unique earn and learn scheme in our college.

Giving Back to Society:

National Immunization Programme and Outreach Activities: Our NSS volunteers give their services during national immunization campaigns in Bhiwandi. NSS unit also reached out to the community in adopted area and conducted outreach activities. NSS volunteers accompanied BNCMC health teams for immunization drives in slum areas.

Our DLLE unit arranges a charity week every February to enable the fortunate to donate school stationery items for the needy. The items collected by DLLE student volunteers in February 2019 were distributed to needy students in Bhiwandi Weaver's Education Society's Weaver's English Medium High School.

Several activities and awareness talks are arranged for students from surrounding schools. Our auditorium is provided free of cost with standard facilities to schools, Social organizations and NGOs, Facilities procured under grants from various sources are shared with colleges.

With guidance from Hon'ble Mr. Aslam Fakhri, President, KME Society, our college adopted KMES High School and Jr. College, Padgha and our Principal and teachers regularly visit the school for quality educational interactions with its staff and students. Visits and interactions are planned in the coming academic year also.

Our students get trained in cyber security measures from Quick Heal Foundation and Cyber cell of Thane Police and in turn have spread the message of cyber security awareness to over 49000 school and college students in the last 2 years.

A legal convergence meeting for ladies from Bhiwandi and surrounding areas was conducted in collaboration with Ngo Majlis, NGO Sahasee and the Police to create awareness on legal aid available.

More such events are planned in near future.

An invited talk on "Role of Genomics in Human Disease Management and Diagnosis" by Dr. Amol Raut, (PhD), Chief Executive Officer, Gene Support, Pune was organized on 30th October, 2019 through video conferencing. Similarly our alumnus Ms. Zainab Farid interacted with current IT students through video-conferencing lecture from Georgia, United States.

Induction Lectures, Opening Address, Principal's Meetings with Students:

Principal Dr Moses J. Kolet assisted by members of the staff and coordinators of key committees conducted induction lectures for all new entrant students in July 2019. Similarly Principal's opening address for all classes were held in the college reopening week. Meetings of student class representatives/ leaders with Principal are held every month.

Short Film Making: Our short film titled ‘Satark’ was sent up to the International Film Festival. Short films themed on Swatcha Bharat Abhiyaan, made by students, won **First Prize** in ‘Goonj’ Intercollegiate Festival of SST College and **Second Prize** in ‘Udaan’ Festival of Somaiya College

Dramatics: In the first time in history of our college, our team ventured into intercollegiate dramatics competition organized by Art Creative Theatre, Bhiwandi, with their play 'Ek Kahani Aisi Bhi' and our all women's team swept all the awards installed namely, Best Play, Best Script Writing, Best Director, Best Actor/Actress, Best Face of the Year, Best Cooperative College and in a first in the 9 year history of this competition, the entire cast was awarded Best Actress awards. I thank the dramatics group under mentorship of Ms. Hiba Shaikh and biotechnology staff for this achievement.

Management of Wastes: The college has initiated composting of garden and kitchen wastes in partnership with NGO Hariyali. E-waste was recycled in collaboration with MPCB approved M/s Green World Recycling.

Short-term Certificate Courses, Training Programmes and Workshops:

Twenty two short-term certificate courses and workshops were conducted this year, all of which received tremendous response from students; **over 2500 students and staff** have taken the benefit of these skill development and value added courses and workshops during this year. Two more are planned in April 2020. Student resource trainers successfully operated several skill courses. I express my heartfelt gratitude to the respective course coordinators for successfully conceptualizing, designing, and running these courses and workshops.
