

This is with reference to 5th Meeting of the Task Force held during 18-20th April, 2019 at Pondicherry University, Pondicherry for Star Status Evaluation of your college. The Expert's decision/comment's are as below:

"Dr. Jayashree Thakre presented the progress and informed that college has acquired NAAC Grade – A accreditation. The Task Force observed that IT project dealing with security on social media etc lack novelty. There were specific queries pertaining to the activities in departments of Physics and IT regarding the correlation between the equipment purchased and experiments listed. It was expected that in future progress reports the college will show the link between the infrastructure created under Star Scheme and its utilisation. The coordinator apprised that the college faculty had several projects and that these have resulted in novel findings for which patents have been filed."

Decision: In view of above, the Task force recommended extension for a period of two years at existing level.

Further, the Task Force reiterated that the Star Colleges should involve maximum number of students under the activities being done under this scheme and that in order to have maximum number of student beneficiaries, the colleges should stress upon procurement of low cost multiple copies of basic equipments required for conducting experiments in the undergraduate classes.

The Advisory committee meetings should be held regularly, at least twice in the tenure of the project, one to be held in the early phase of its implementation so as to guide the college about the scheme and another towards the middle for mid-term course correction, if required. DBT may nominate the task force members for this purpose, if felt necessary. Colleges should ensure that external advisory members should be representing the domain expert area while trying to avoid the potential conflict of interests that might arise due to such nominations.

It was suggested that coordinators should include a page on budget utilisation and another one describing the quantum of the committed objectives achieved while presenting their progress.
