



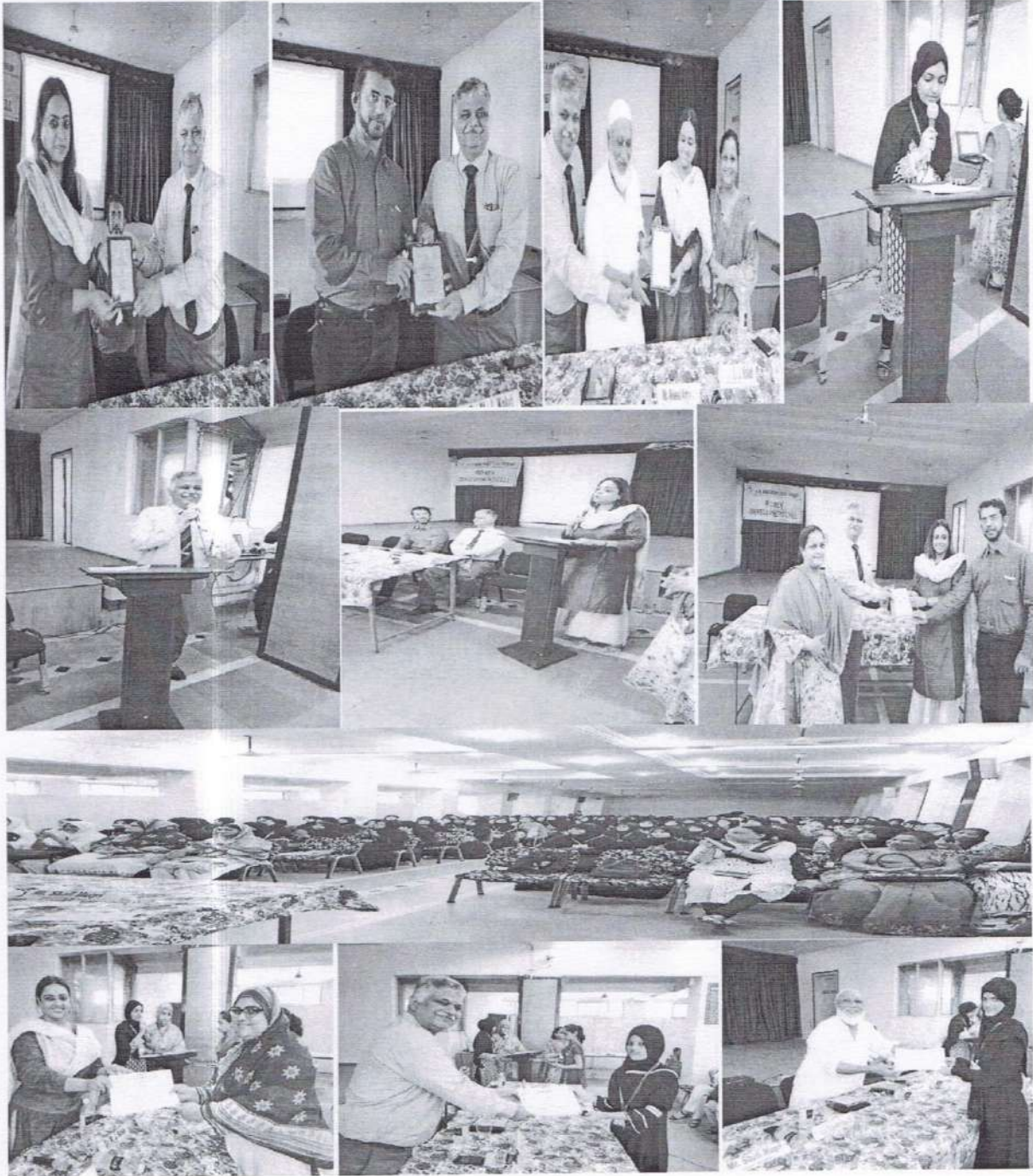

Women Development Cell of K.M.E. Society’s G.M Momin Women’s College in collaboration with MAJLIS Legal Centre had organized a One Day Regional Seminar on “Know Your Rights-Muslim Legal Rights” on 11th September, 2017 in the college auditorium. The schedule time was from 8:30 am to 2:00 pm. The programme began with the welcome address by the representative of Women Development Cell, Ms. Alma Shaikh followed by the recitation of Qirat. Key address was given by Principal Dr.M.J.Kolet. Adv. Naushin Yousuf, the representative of MAJLIS Legal Centre, put forth the issue of ‘Triple Talaq’ and the legal rights pertaining to divorce for the women belonging to the Muslim Community. The programme acquainted the students of the college as well as the teacher and student and teachers of nearby locality with the knowledge of the recent law passed by the Supreme Court on ‘Triple Talaq’ which is also a hotly debated topic nation-wide. Adv. Naushin Yousuf highlighted the conditions and circumstances in which a Muslim woman or a man can avail divorce right fully, and also briefed up the rulings of divorce for those belonging to other religious communities. In the concluding session Principal Dr.M.J. Kolet and the Chairperson of Rais High School & Junior College Mr. Shafi Muqri also shared their positive views regarding the empowerment of students and to help them recognize their rights as a broader part of being women of the society.

The One Day Regional Seminar helped the students and teachers to focus with a broad perspective on the issues existing in society. There were interactive sessions with the audience simultaneously throughout the programme. The students gave a positive feedback that they became aware of many of their rights which they were unaware about before the seminar.

Vote of Thanks was delivered at the end of the seminar and the programme ended with the National Anthem.
